- Members must have completed a minimum of three years of Girl Scout membership.

Qualifications and core competencies:

- Members must be able to communicate clearly.
- Members must have access to a computer and the ability to communicate via email.
- Members must have the ability to participate in phone or online conference calls and/or webinars.

Responsibilities:

- Members will provide a welcoming atmosphere for all alumnae.
- Members will serve as a point of contact for alumnae in their program specialty.
- Members will serve as a spokesperson for volunteers regarding operations, programs, and Council policies as requested by GSGWM's Chief Executive Officer.
- Members will serve as a spokesperson for GSGWM in relaying information to alumnae.
- Members will attend meetings or conference calls as scheduled by the Chief Executive Officer.
