Now is the time to plan for your summer camp adventure! Registration is open and popular weeks go fast. If you are earning Program Credits through the Girl Scout Cookie program, they can help you cover the cost of camp.

We have so many options, you’re bound to find a summer camp program that fits your special interests. New this summer are a family camp mystery weekend, a weeklong pool party, as well as programs like Paint Palooza, Pixie Dust, Animal Tales, Day Camp CIT and more! Of course, you’ll still have your old favorites, too – songs, campfires, games, crafts, and friendships both new and renewed.

Girl Scouts who have completed Kindergarten-Grade 8 can sign up for one-week day camp programs at Camp Kettleford in Bedford, NH; Camp Seawood in Portsmouth, NH; and Camp Twin Hills in Richmond, VT. Additionally, all three day camp locations offer two-week programs for Girl Scouts who have completed grade 6-10. Those who have finished Grades 2-12 have the option of one- or two-week overnight sessions at Camp Farnsworth in Thetford, VT. There’s even a special three-night experience at Farnsworth called Frolic for any girl who has finished Grades 1-5 and wants to get a taste of camp without the full-week commitment. 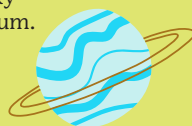

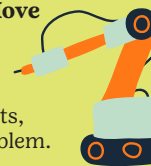

Cookies teach financial literacy

There's no better way for a Girl Scout to become financially literate than through participation in the Girl Scout Cookie program! When you take part, you become an entrepreneur – that's a business owner – learning five important skills:

People skills

Money management

Business ethics

Goal setting

Decision making

As you practice these five skills, you can earn badges at every level of Girl Scouting. Daisies can learn about paper money and coins with the Money Explorer and find out how to spend wisely with My Money Choices. The Brownie Budget Builder and My Own Budget badges help you understand what it means to make a plan for your financial goals. Juniors expand their budgeting skills with Budget Maker and My Money Plan badges. Cadettes may earn budget badges, too, plus create positive habits with My Money Habits. Seniors can become Savvy Savers and explore investing with My Financial Power. Ambassadors discover how to build and keep an eye on credit and make informed decisions about borrowing with My Financial Planner and My Financial Independence.

In addition to the troop proceeds you earn with every package of cookies sold, you also earn Program Credits! Each package of cookies provides for both, but the Program Credits are all yours to spend on membership fees, program fees, camp, at the Mountain Top Shop, or for council or Destinations travel. Our Program Credits are valid only within our council.

Final Payment is due June 1, 2024

Once the deposit is paid and your camper is registered, you can log back into your account to see balance due and make payments. You can make payments, use Cookie Program Credits, or make a decision based on a financial assistance application through June 1, when all balances are due. Families with outstanding balances after June 1 may lose their spot at camp; be sure to pay the balance due on time. Campers will not be permitted to attend camp if there is a balance due for any session.

Cookie Program Credits

Planning to use Cookie Program Credit to pay for camp? Cookie Program Credits may be used to pay for camp fees.

2023 Cookie Program Credits expire March 31, 2024.

2024 Cookie Program Credits will be issued first week in May.

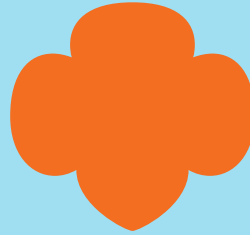
