Purpose: After receiving the Leadership Development pin your leaves display the initiative and steps you have taken to increase your skills in working with girls and to provide them with all opportunities Girl Scouts has to offer.

Criteria:

10 contact hours or one CEU or adult learning opportunity/training = 1 green leaf

5 green leaves or 50 contact hours or 5 CEUs of additional training = 1 silver leaf

5 silver leaves or 250 contact hours or 25 CEUs of additional training = 1 gold leaf

After 1,250 contact hours or 125 CEUs of additional training you will have 5 gold leaves displayed on your Leadership Development pin.
