

Anchor Watch Programs at Mystic Seaport

We would love to welcome you aboard the youth overnight programs at Mystic Seaport! The Anchor Watch program provides an exciting overnight experience for all ages of Girl Scouts aboard the historic tall ship, *Joseph Conrad*. Programs are held on Friday and Saturday evenings in the Spring and Fall and all include two days of admission to Mystic Seaport, pizza snack, breakfast and, weather permitting, a chance to climb the rigging! Here are just a few of the different types of programs we offer:

A Taste of History \$75 per person

The Taste of History program is perfect for all ages and is a great general introduction to Mystic Seaport and maritime history. Take a personalized nighttime tour of the Seaport, spend some time aboard a vessel learning about its purpose and life aboard ship. After a pizza snack do some scrimshaw to learn about Sailor's crafts.

Destination Outer Space (for Brownie Scouts)

\$80 per person

Open up a whole new world! Come explore the stars while earning credit towards your Space Explorer Try-It. Gaze at the stars rain or shine at your personal Planetarium show. Afterwards, if there's a clear night sky, you can put your skills to use and find constellations on the walk back to the classroom for pizza! Before bed, make your own constellations and make draw and explore space outfits. In the morning make a simple sundial and keep track of time using shadows.

Sky Watcher (for Junior Girl Scouts) \$80 per person

Explore the "world" above! During your overnight, earn credit towards your Sky Search Badge. Enjoy our Planetarium and learn about constellations, planets, the North Star, meteors, and the moon. Following the show, enjoy a pizza snack, followed by news of what man is doing in space this very night. Before bed, hear a nighttime story or two about the stars.

Women in History (for Cadette and Senior Girl Scouts) \$75 per person

Experience the past first hand! Receive a visit from one of our 1876 role-players. They will provide you with a special presentation entitled, "Dressing the Victorian Woman". Girls will earn credit toward their Women Through Time Interest Project by learning about the details of late 19th century dress and etiquette.
