7 Steps to the Bronze Award



Prerequisite:

Go on a Junior Journey, including the Journey's Take Action™ project.



Step 1:

Identify issues that you're passionate about and how they affect your community.



Step 2:

Build your team. Work with your troop or on your own. Either way, plan to partner with the community.



Step 3:

Explore your community to learn more about issues that interest you. This can be your neighborhood, your school, Girl Scouts, your place of worship, or another community of interest.



Step 4:

Choose your Bronze Award project based on your passions and what you've learned by exploring your community and talking to others.



Step 5:

Make a plan and with your Troop Leader and Team to carry out your Bronze Award

Take Action project.



Step 6:

Put your plan in motion. You and your team will each spend about 20 hours to earn the award. Planning time counts too! Use a Time Log to track your time.



Step 7:

Spread the word and submit your

final report. Inspire others! You can give a presentation to another Girl Scout troop, your local Girl Scout community, or to students at school. Turn in your final report to your council before September 30 after completing 5th grade.
