# Earn the Girl Scout RecrHOOTment PATCH



WHOOO do you know that would make a great Girl Scout?

All you have to do is complete the following 2 steps and when you are done, request your cute owl patch at <u>girlscoutsgwm.org/youreinvited</u>!

Need supplies like printed invitations, yard signs, stickers, etc. to complete the steps? Contact your local membership staff person or Customer Care at 888-474-9686 and we will get them to you!

## Step 1:

#### Whooo Do you know? Invite some friends to join!

Invite 4 friends who are not Girl Scouts yet to join! You can print and hand out or mail these awesome Olive the Owl invites: <u>bit.ly/</u> <u>gsgwmrecrhootmentinvite</u> —or, you can make your own! (If you make your own, make sure to include our website, <u>girlscoutsgwm.org</u> and phone number, 888-474-9686 so they know how to get in touch!

### Step 2:

#### Give a Hoot! Select 3 of these options to help us share the Girl Scout message!

- Use social media to spread the word about Girl Scouts! Ask your parents to use their social media accounts to share a picture of you doing your favorite Girl Scout activity, add a message about why you enjoy being a Girl Scout and why friends should join too! Include our Council weblink (www.girlscoutsgwm.org), phone number (888-474-9686), and use the hashtag #joinGSGWM.
- Hand out 10 door hangers to families you know in your neighborhood. Contact our office to request door hangers or print your own from the PDF provided on our website: <u>bit.ly/</u><u>gsgwmrecrhootmenthanger</u>.
- Do you live on a busy street? Request a yard sign from your local staff member and display it in your yard.
- Wear your uniform or a Girl Scout shirt to school and talk to at least five friends about Girl Scouts.

#### Step 2: Continued

- Make a poster letting people know that they can Text FRIEND to 59618 to learn more about joining Girl Scouts! Hang it in your window at home, post on your locker or cubby at school, ask your parents to put up a poster at their workplace, or anywhere else other girls might see it!
- Ask your teacher if you can do a 5-minute talk about Girl Scouts. This works for virtual school too! Ask your staff
  person, and she can give you stickers, bookmarks or fun activity sheets to give out to your class. If you have
  virtual school, we could even give you a video to share!
- Bring a friend with you to a Girl Scout event, like one of our Family Game Nights online or in your community! See a list of opportunities at <u>girlscoutsgwm.org/youreinvited</u>.
- Write an article about what you love about Girl Scouts and how to join for a school or community newspaper.
- Sing Make New Friends with new friends! Teach this timeless Girl Scout song to some pals
- Promote Girl Scouts at your place of worship. Ask if you can put up a poster or yard sign, speak during the announcements, put info the bulletin, etc.
- Host your own online get-to-know Girl Scouts party! Invite some friends and teach them some games, songs, crafts, or skills you learned in Girl Scouts!
- Are you in dance, sports, or another activity? Share Girl Scout information at your center.
- Make your own skit, song or commercial about why being a Girl Scout is awesome! Share it with friends and family or ask your parents to share it on their social media!
- Have another idea about how to get the word out? Get creative and make up your own activity!
