Below are some of the important things that go into making a great troop. We offer a variety of volunteer roles for troop families. Below are positions, their descriptions, and time commitments, mark the positions that you think you can do. Help us make it a great year!

Position	Quick Description	Yes, I can do this!
Troop Leader (each troop needs a minimum of 2)	- Keeps troop records. - Works with co-leader(s) and the girls to plan and execute meetings. - Attends Service Unit Leader meetings. - May attend special events and field trips. - Maintain regular communication with families. - Typically, 2-3 hours a week	
Troop Helper	- Attends troop meetings to assist leaders. - Typically, 45 minutes to 1 hour	
Troop Product Sale Coordinator (Cookie or Fall Product)	- Coordinates troop participation in the Fall Product Sale and/or Cookie Sale Program. - Attends Council/Service Unit training for preparation of the role. - Coordinates cookie booths for the troop. - Cookie Program Coordinator only - Trains girls and families at troop meetings. - Ensures that girls receive product sale incentives. - Depends on the time of year - Fall Product lasts for 1 month - Cookie Season lasts for 3 months	
Troop Treasurer	- Gives guidance regarding troop financial affairs such as product sales and money earning activities. - Assist troop leaders in keeping accounts and making sure financial reports are turned in on a timely basis. - Typically, 45 minutes a week	

What is required to volunteer?

Troop volunteers are required to purchase a Girl Scouts of the USA membership, complete a background check, and complete training specific to the role.
