Candidates for the council board and the governance committee must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Accept the principles, beliefs, and purpose of Girl Scouting
- 2. Understand cultural, social, and economic trends nationally and locally, and their effects on Girl Scouting and its activities
- 3. Be available to attend board and committee meetings. (The Board meets 5 times per year. Committee meeting schedules vary, but usually do not exceed 7 or 8 times per year.)
- 4. Be a minimum of 18 years of age at the time of election
- 5. Be willing to make a personally significant annual contribution to the council and solicit funds for the council

If you are not selected to be a candidate for board membership, you may also be considered for membership on a board committee, board task group or other positions.
