



TGOC vs. VGOC

Customers may wish to support Girl Scout troops but may not want to purchase cookies for themselves. Troops can suggest to customers that cookie purchases may be donated instead. This supports the troop, supports hometown heroes in the community, and customers are happy knowing they have made a difference all around.

There are two ways your troop can account for these donations.

VGOC - Virtual Gift of Caring. These are distributed by the council office. Recipients are within GSGWM. Troops do not need to provide inventory to fulfill these orders.

TGOC - Troop Gift of Caring. Troops decide who they would like to show thanks to, be it a group, organization, or community entity and deliver donated packages to that recipient. These packages are fulfilled from the troop's physical inventory.

In both,

- Troops receive proceeds for the sale.
- Girl Scouts received credit for these sales.
