

# Donated Cookies: Record Under VGOC

Girl Scouts of the Green and White Mountains is streamlining our cookie donation process in eBudde. Moving forward, only Virtual Gift of Caring (VGOC) will be visible in the system. With this change, troops will enter donated packages on the VGOC column but will no longer maintain physical cookie inventory for donations. Council will now handle all inventory for VGOC packages and distribution.

Council will distribute donated cookies—on behalf of both the council and participating troops—to a variety of local hometown heroes and community organizations, including food banks, nursing homes, hospitals, and service members.



We recognize that many troops will welcome this simplified approach. However, we also understand that some troops may have a preferred local organization for cookie donations or would like to personally deliver donated packages. If your troop would like to donate to a specific organization:

If council is unable to make that delivery, your troop may pick up cookies from your nearest Cookie Cupboard and deliver them directly.

Troops may request additional cookies beyond the number donated in eBudde, and council may also be able to provide extra packages to support your donation efforts.

As you prepare for upcoming cookie booths, please continue to promote Gift of Caring. Donors can be assured that their contributions will support organizations across both states that give back to our communities.

However, please remember that troops should not promote a specific organization for Gift of Caring unless they have confirmed council will be donating to the location or the troop will be able to pick up cookies and deliver cookies to that location themselves.
