What are Fall Products?



Through the Fall Product program, Girl Scouts experience entrepreneurship and troops earn proceeds. Customers can purchase quality nuts, candy, or chocolates in person or online, delivered by a Girl Scout or shipped directly to their home.



Also available are online-only items including favorite magazine subscriptions, BarkBox items, or Tervis products shipped directly to the customer. **NEW** this year are a variety of scented candles and personalized stationery products.

Earn proceeds for troop activities!

20% per item

of retail price for nut, candy, or tin item sold online or in person.

New! \$4 per item

for all magazine subscriptions, BarkBox, Tervis, candles, or personalized stationery items.

2026 Important Dates

September 21- October 1:

Leaders access the Fall Product site, gsnutsandmags.com/gsgwm. Check roster, contact Customer Care for any changes.

October 1:

Fall Product Program begins! Girl Scouts set up their site and begin taking orders online and in person.

October 1 - 25:

Girl Scouts and families enter in-person orders. Girl Scouts should make reward choices on all levels.

October 23:

Leaders, send a reminder to families that they have two days left to enter in-person orders.

October 25:

Girl Scouts' last day to enter in-person orders.

October 26:

Final day volunteers can edit in-person orders. Orders for online shipped items and girl delivery purchased online are added automatically. This is the last day to choose rewards for Girl Scouts or troops to opt out.

November 13-14:

Delivery of orders to the service units.

November 14-November 30:

Girl Scouts deliver product to customers. Collect and deposit money promptly.

December 4:

Troop accounts automatically debited the amount due to council. (ACH Sweep) troop proceeds remain in the account!

Early December:

Estimated time when rewards arrive to service units. Distribute as soon as possible.

Girl Scouts participate online, in person, or both!

How to get started in the Fall Product Program!

Before the program begins

- All Girl Scouts and volunteers must be registered for the 2026-2027 membership year.
- Attend a program training with your service unit.
- Discuss with your troop what activities they'd like to do this year and the funds your troop will need to do them. Discuss if the troop would like to opt out of rewards for an additional **fifteen cents** per item in troop proceeds (if so, select this option on your troop dashboard before October 26).
- Share with families the troop's goals, and how families can help.
- On or after September 21, watch for an email with access to the Fall Product website (M2). Review your roster. After October 1, you'll find helpful reports or send messages to your troop with reminders, updates, and kudos. Assist entering Girl Scouts' orders, if needed, between October 10-October 26.

In person or online. Easy!

Girl Scouts can take orders on their paper order cards, or once they build their online site, can send their site to friends and family. They can also share their online site through text messages or social links through their online account.



Customers can support by donating

Customers may want an additional way to support your Girl Scouts. All **\$6** Care to Share donations will provide sweet treats to our active U.S. military personnel through Operation Gratitude.

Easy for Girl Scouts and families

Families will receive an email on October 1. Their Girl Scout can log in, confirm their troop number, then create a password. If they missed the email, they can simply log in to **gsnutsandmags.com/gsgwm** and follow the on-screen prompts.

Girl Scouts and families will enter all in-person orders directly into their site. They click on Manage Paper Orders, enter the total number of in-person units for each product item. Click Update. *All online orders will be added automatically.* There is no final submit button.

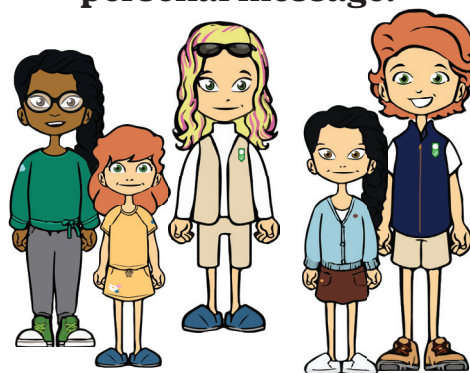
