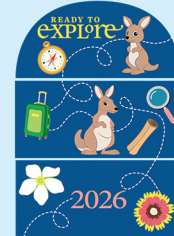

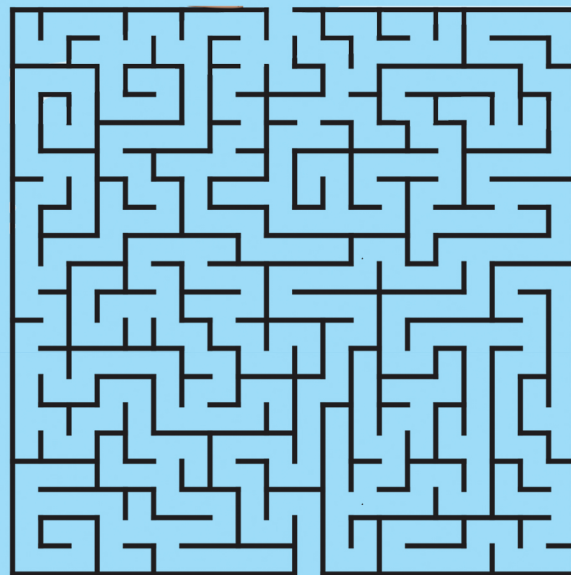

- Girl Scouts learn and practice skills like goal setting, decision making, money management, people skills and business ethics as they earn proceeds for their troop.
- The Fall Product Program is an excellent way to earn start up proceeds to fund your troop's activities and projects throughout the year.
- Proceeds stay local to benefit our council and troops earn 20% on all nut and chocolate items sold (online or in person), plus \$4 per item of all other online products.

How the Program Works

This program allows Girl Scouts to be entrepreneurs by offering family and friends the opportunity to purchase from a variety of products. There are two ways to participate:

- In-person by taking orders using the nut order card and collecting payments.
- Online by inviting friends and family to order. Customers can choose to have nuts and chocolates, Girl Scout themed BarkBoxes, magazines, and much, much more shipped directly to them. They can also choose select nut and chocolate items for Girl Scout delivery.

Important Dates

- **October 1:** Program begins – Girl Scouts set up their online site and may sell in-person or online.
- **October 25:** Last day of order taking AND deadline to enter order card items into the online system.
- **November 13-14:** Nut and chocolate items will be delivered to Service Unit sites. Contact your leader for information where and when to pick up your orders.
- **November 14-30:** Deliver orders promptly. Collect any payments for orders not paid online. Turn money into your troop leader as soon as possible.
