CHARGE TO THE ALUMNAE ADVISORY BOARD

PURPOSE:

The Alumnae Advisory Board has been established to serve as a council liaison, serving as the voice of alumnae for GSGWM's Chief Executive Officer.

COMPOSITION:

- 1. The members of the Alumnae Advisory Board will be appointed by the Chief Executive Officer.
- 2. The Alumnae Advisory Board shall consist of between six and ten appointed members.
- 3. All members of the Alumnae Advisory Board must be currently registered members of GSUSA.
- 4. All members of the Alumnae Advisory Board must have completed the volunteer intake process and must have a current background check on file.
- 5. All members of the Alumnae Advisory Board must have completed at least three years of Girl Scout membership during their lifetime.

KEY DUTIES:

- 1) Participate in regularly scheduled meetings with members of the Advancement Department and/or the Chief Executive Officer.
- 2) Serve in leadership roles within the association where appropriate.
- 3) Serve as spokesperson for, and liaison to, alumnae as requested by the Chief Executive Officer and Advancement Department.
- 4) Provide input on alumnae programs and initiatives and develop priorities as requested by the Chief Executive Officer.
- 5) Participate in outreach and engagement strategies intended to grow membership and participation in the GSGWM Alumnae Association programs and activities.
